TRIENNIAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF SBIOA, BHOPAL CIRCLE ASSOCIATION ON 25/03/2018

SBIOA Bhopal Circle had organised its 26th General Body Meeting in a grand manner at Maulana Azad College of Technology, Bhopal on Sunday the 25th March 2018. The inaugural session commenced with the Saraswathi Vandana by the troupe of SBI Staff & Association.

2. The meeting hall was Jam-packed with enthusiastic members, who came from every nook and corner of the Circle. The guests were received with crackers and bouquet and raising of slogans of "SBIOA" Zindabad" "AISBOF Zindabad" by enthusiastic members of SBIOA, Bhopal Circle, and taken to the well decorated dais at 11:00 a.m for the inaugural session of the meeting.

3. Com.Sanjeev Sabhlok, General Secretary of the Circle Association welcomed the guests and the members. He complimented the Circle Association leadership for taking everyone into confidence and delivering the best to the membership. He expressed his appreciation to the membership for their full attendance; which exhibits their love, affection and trust on Association and its leadership.

4. Shri K.T. Ajit, Chief General Manager, SBI Bhopal Circle was the chief Guests. Shri Kaushik Sinha, GM-NW-2, Shri C.R.S Powar, GM-NW-3 Smt. Geeta Pillai, DGM & CDO were also present in the AGM as Special Invitees.

5. The Circle Association invited all retired/Ex-Principal office-bearers of SBIOA Bhopal like S/Shri N.K. Jain, M.C. Shrivastava, Ravi Bilgaiyan, Samir

6. Felicitations of election committee members and election tribunal, election advisory committee.

7. Felicitations of cricketer Mr. Sanjay Pandey. Felicitations of retired comrade Mr. Avinash Nimade, R.N. Vijay Vargiya, Mr. Rakesh Jadaon and Shri Pradeep Kumar Nigam.

8. The dignitaries on the dais were felicitated in traditional way offering "Tilak" and floral bouquets.

9. Com. Arun Bagoliwal, General Secretary of Staff Union, Bhopal Circle spoke and extended fraternal greetings and oppose ill-effects of social media.

10. Com. Y. Sudarshan, General Secretary, AISBOF, Co. Thomas Franco, President, AIBOC in their key note address, while addressing the gathering placed before some of the practical difficulties are being faced due to acute shortage of staff. Insufficient staff at branches leading to late sitting and working on Sundays and Holidays, is affecting the health and family life of the officers. They also deliberated regarding the difficulties faced by the officers and staff during the demonetization period, and the Government of India and IBA appreciated the untiring efforts SBI staff for their day and night contribution rendered in the national cause. They urged upon the bank Management to extend adequate compensation to the staff members for the toiling during the demonetization period. Both the leaders expressed concern of the privatization of PSU and raising unemployment in the country, low family pension, charter of demand, reason of deferment of strike on 15/03/2018, PNB Scam, smart compensation, present banking scenario, Belongingness of Scale-IV to Scale-V with the Association, revision

of long pending pension, RBI penalty, gratuity amendment bill and transfer policy.

11. They also explain recent development/achievements/facility like

- I. 100% Medical reimbursement for family.
- II. Bank circular on Work life balance.
- III. Waiver of Scrutiny of medical bill upto Rs.2000/-.
- IV. 1 week bereavement leave in case of death of member's in family.
- V. Introduction of Vacation policy.
- VI. GST on brief case.
- VII. Extension of repayment of vehicle loan after retirement.
- VIII. Inclusion of cost of solar panel in Housing Loan.

12. Com. Thomas Franco in his speech spoke about the following issues like:

1. Opposition by the AIBOC to Privatization.
2. Charter of demand, work on home, work life balance.
3. Staff welfare amount on gross profit instead of net profit.
4. Stop FRDI bill.
5. Early wage revision and negotiation.
6. Compensation of demonetization etc.

13. He complimented the Circle leadership of organizing the General Body meeting immediately after assuming the charge. He assured the Circle leadership of all the co-operation from the Federation in serving the officers.
